## MVESC'S KHOURY NAMED OUTSTANDING ADMINISTRATOR

ZANESVILLE -- James Khoury, director of the Muskingum Valley Educational Service Center (MVESC) School Psychological Services Department, recently was honored as the 2009 Outstanding Administrator of the Southeast Region of the Ohio School Boards Association. The award was presented at the region's annual fall conference in Logan.

Khoury has served as the director of School Psychological Services for the past 24 years. He provides leadership to a team of eight school psychologists and 10 behavior technicians. The group provides services around intervention and direct services, consultation, student achievement services and educational services for children with autism in Coshocton, Morgan and Muskingum counties. Numerous visitors from around the state have consulted Khoury's expertise around autism and have visited the MVESC Preschool Little Feats Program.

Khoury earned a master's degree in school psychology from Ohio University and then obtained his Ohio license in school psychology a few years later.
