You become a member of a team of experts.

At Muskingum Valley ESC, you will become a member of an 11-person team of school psychologists and one clinical psychologist. In addition to the traditional services that are provided on a daily basis, each team member has or is developing one or more specialized areas of expertise based on his or her individual training, experience and interests. Our districts know that, in addition to the school psychologist who serves their student, building or district, Muskingum Valley offers a staff of highly-trained psychologists who can provide specialized consultation, program planning and development, and intensive work with children, regardless of the nature and severity of their difficulties.

We encourage active participation in these groups and have past state and regional organizational presidents on our staff.

Why Should I Join the MVESC Team of School Psychologists?

MVESC hosts school psychology interns.

Historically, Muskingum Valley has successfully supervised 13 school psychology interns from the Master's, Educational Specialist and Doctoral level throughout the 1980s, 1990s and 2000s. We also are proud to share that five of our former interns are currently employed with MVESC full time. We are an approved site through the Ohio School Psychologist Intern Training Program and will be hosting a school psychology intern for the upcoming school year.

MVESC offers a competitive salary package.

Muskingum Valley ESC believes in the value of school psychologists. Salaries begin at \$56,493 for a 202-day contract and extend to \$73,404 based on years of experience. MVESC offers a comprehensive insurance package that includes medical, vision, dental and life. For applicants with a Ph.D., an additional stipend is included.
